

Dear Community Partner:

Christiana Care is hosting a special community event to vaccinate adults 65 and older who live in the communities most impacted by COVID-19.

Date: February 5, 2021

Time: 11:00am to 6:00pm (See below for the appointment times)

Location: Community Education Building - 1200 N. French Street, Wilmington, DE

We ask that each of you contact individuals served by your organization, who are 65 years of age or older to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

Here's what you need to know ...

- Vaccination hours assigned to the individuals you invite to this event will be 12:00pm to 2:00pm.
- Please obtain the name, phone number and date of birth for every individual that you recruit to receive the vaccine. Please enter this information in the excel spreadsheet provided.
- Please ask individuals to bring a photo ID (only to be used as proof of age).
- The vaccine is free of charge.
- Vaccine doses continue to be in limited supply, based on shipments we receive from the state. A limited number of doses will be available during this event and will be provided only to individuals who have been signed up before Friday, February 5.
- The vaccination process itself takes about 20 minutes, so it is recommended to plan for 30 minutes to allow for wait times.



About receiving the second dose:

Everyone who is vaccinated at this event will be entered into the ChristianaCare list for second vaccination. They will be contacted when vaccine supplies become available.
